Pigeon River

Surrounded by the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, the Cherokee National Forest, Martha Sundquist State Forest and the Appalachian Trail, the Pigeon River winds through our old mountains covered in hardwood trees and wildflowers.

The Pigeon River's close proximity to the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Gatlinburg, Pigeon Forge, Maggie Valley and Asheville provides an accessible and exciting trip for group tours of all ages.

(We are just off Interstate 40 at the Tennessee/NC line.)

We offer group tours:

- A step-on greeting
- Free parking
- A discounted rate for groups of 10 ppl or more
- A picnic area for lunch and snack breaks, optional lunch available from Eddie's Dog House
- Activities open Memorial Day- Labor Day
- Hot showers and changing rooms
- 1 hour from Asheville, NC, 1:15 from Pigeon Forge, TN

Rafting on the Big Pigeon River is divided into two sections. The Upper Pigeon Trip is more exciting while the Lower Pigeon Trip is a relaxing scenic experience. Our Pigeon River Canopy Tours offers a soaring and gliding experience naturally fueled by an elevation change in the Smoky Mountains. Fly beside, above and 1200' across the Pigeon River and back at heights up to 120 feet above the river.

Guided Whitewater Rafting Trip- Upper Section

Raft an exciting dam-controlled river in the Great Smoky Mountains with an experienced raft guide.

- Upper section for exciting rapids (class II, III & IV rapids)
- 2 hour total trip time (1 hour on water)
- Guided trips with 6 ppl plus guide in each raft
- Available only on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday after 11.
- Must be 8 years old and over

Group rates for 10 ppl or more: \$34.95 per person

Guided Rafting Trip—Lower Section

Raft the lower section of the river for a fun scenic float trip with an experienced raft guide.

- 2 hour total trip time (1 ½ hours on water)
- Guided trip with 6 ppl plus guide in each raft
- Available only on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday after 11.
- Must be 4 years old and over

Group rates for 10 ppl or more: \$29.95 per person



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Pigeon River Zipline Tour

This zipline experience gives you a great introductory sampling of adventure ziplining. Allow 2 ½ hours, smaller groups might complete the course faster. The River Ziplines Tour includes:

- Training and practice on easier ziplines first – Ground School
- 7 zip line sections through the trees from elevated platforms
- 2 Pigeon River crossings including the Highline, a 1300' long & 120' high final zip
- 3 tree top “sky bridges” viewing the Smoky Mountains from new heights
- Over 9 scenic and historic acres of flying area all within the setting of Wildwater Pigeon
- Age/Weight: 10 yrs and over, 70-250 lbs.

Group rates for 10 ppl or more: \$59 per person

Waterfall Gorge Canopy Tour

This canopy tour takes visitors deep into a Smoky Mountain Creek Gorge exposing a lush forest of ferns, wildflowers, towering trees, rock cliffs, cascading waterfalls and moss covered boulder gardens. Allow 3 1/2 hours, smaller groups might complete the course faster. The Waterfall Gorge Canopy Tour includes:

- Training and practice on easier ziplines first – Ground School
- 12 zipline sections between elevated platforms & treetop deck
- 4 sky bridges
- The “Cliff Hanger” platform perched on a 100' rock cliff
- Scenic Smoky Mountain Creek cascades
- 2 Pigeon River crossings including the Highline, a 1300' long & 120' high final zip
- Over 15 scenic and historic acres of flying area launching from the Wildwater Pigeon.
- Age/Weight: 10 yrs and over, 70-250 lbs.

Group rates for 10 ppl or more: \$77 per person

The Pigeon River Canopy Tours are exceptional and unique to the area. Each course culminates in an exciting 1,200 foot long return side-by-side zip 120 feet over the river. Begin your zip experience at our ground school before you head to the Jenga Tower to start your tour.

While zipping is not a strenuous activity, you do have to be able to climb the stairs of our zipping tower. The speed of the guest is manually controlled, therefore every guest participates in ground school and on our “practice” ziplines.

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
